Andrew Treletsky earned his "black shirt" by capturing his second ABT title at Fair Lanes Oakton this past weekend. Andrew barely made it into the semi-finals qualifying with a -41 that got him the last spot of 24 men who qualified. The semi-finals was a totally different story as Andrew got hot and rolled a 652 handicap series to earn the top spot for the stepladder finals. His opponent in the championship match was William Russell from Minooka. William qualified fifth for the finals and was nothing short of sensational as he won his first three matches 231-217, 232-224, and 245-196 to move into the championship game. After six frames only 8 pins separated the two bowlers as they matched each other mark for mark, but open frames by William in the 7th and 9th gave Andrew a commanding

lead heading into the 10th. William came back with 3 strikes in the 10th to close the gap but it wasn't enough and Andrew came away with the victory by a final count of 218-199.

Andrew Treletsky is 24 years old and makes his home in Chicago. He is employed as a driver for a plastics engineering company. He is single and has been bowling for about 5 or 6 years. He currently bowls leagues at Waveland and Classic Bowl. Andrew has a high game of 256 to go along with a 668 series as his personal bests. Andrew was using a Blue Hammer which was drilled by Jessie at Diversey River Bowl. Andrew said that he got help and encouragement from his fellow ABT bowlers this week which helped him through the semi-finals and finals. Andrew thanked his Mom & Dad, Fair Lanes Oakton, the ABT, and all the people who stayed to watch the finals and make them so exciting. Andrew plans to pay off some bills with his \$800 earnings. He said he loves bowling in the ABT and this is the best tournament for an amateur.
