DALKE ON TOP AT NU-VISION!!!

Dave Dalke, from River Grove, had the best weekend of his bowling career and it paid off big at Nu-Vision Entertainment Center. Dave led all qualifiers on Saturday with a blistering handicap series of 964 to win the high prepaid series prize worth \$118. Dave is one of our lifetime members so he was automatically eligible for that prize. But the hot streak had just begun. Dave continued his torrid pace on Sunday with a 704 handicap series in the semi-finals which earned him the top spot in our stepladder finals. Qualifying second for the finals was Dave's dad, James Dalke, but the potential father and son championship match was derailed when third seeded Joe Scaglione Jr. rolled a clutch double in the 10th

frame to pull out a 176-165 victory over James. That may have sparked Dave even more as he picked up in the championship match right where he left off in the semi-finals. Dave opened with a spare and five consecutive strikes and never looked back as he picked up the \$800 first prize by a final count of 240-155.

Dave Dalke is a 25 year old graduate student of Northwestern University. He is single and has been bowling since the age of 5. Dave currently bowls league at Mages Bowl. He has a high game of 267 with a 702 series to his credit. Dave was using a Columbia Bud II which was drilled by Paul Marcinek at Lakeside Bowl. Dave said that he has received help with his game from his dad, James Dalke, and a friend, Rich Gucwa. Dave thanked the ABT for coming to Chicagoland. He also thanked his mom, Bonnie, and his dad, James, along with all the spectators for their support. Dave said that the win couldn't have come at a better time as he was hoping to be able to take a trip to Europe. Now, Dave said, "I'm going to buy the ticket on Monday." Dave loved the lane conditions this week and thinks the ABT is fantastic. "It's a great format. Everything is fair and everyone has an equal chance to win." I couldn't have said it better myself, Dave.
