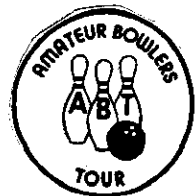

John has only been bowling for 3 years and currently bowls league at Espo's Country Lanes. John has a high game of 215 and a 549 series, both of which came in this week's semi-finals. John thanked her for talking him into bowling in the tournament. He also thanked his friends, Steve Shiflett and Ron Stines, along with all the spectators for their support during the finals.
