It took a lot of convincing to get David Hazelbaker to bowl in his first ABT tournament. I don't think it will take much to get him back as David became one of those few lucky bowlers to win in his very first attempt, but it wasn't easy. Fortunately for David, the cut score stayed low and his -19 was good enough to make the semi-finals. He finished the semis at +5 which put him in a three way tie for 3rd, 4th and 5th positions in our stepladder finals which forced a three way roll-off to determine who would be placed where. David was the last bowler up in the roll-off and managed to throw a clutch double in the 10th frame to earn the 3rd position by 3 pins. From there he was unstoppable as he defeated his 3 oppo-

nents by scores of 252-188, 208-143, and 185-163 to claim the \$800 first prize.

David Hazelbaker is a 36 year old Senior Chief Petty Officer in the U.S. Navy. He and his wife Bernadette have an 11 year old son, Davy. This is David's first year back in bowling since 1976. He currently bowls league at Brunswick Lakehurst. David has a high game of 256 and the 555 scratch total that he rolled in the finals was his best ever. David was using a Columbia Yellow Dot which he had drilled when he was stationed at the Submarine Base at Pearl Harbor. David said that his teammate and fellow ABT member Jeff Campbell has been working with him to help improve his game. He thanked Jeff along with Mel Apilado for talking him into joining the ABT. He also thanked the ABT and Brunswick Lakehurst for having the Tournament. His winnings, he said, will go to his wife, Bernadette. David just returned from Las Vegas where he had the opportunity to see the Professional Bowlers Tour in action and he couldn't believe how much the ABT is structured just like the pros. His final comment, and I quote, "This is the most fun I've ever had with my clothes on." 'Nuff said!
