## BOBRICK CAPTURES TITLE AT BERTRANDS!

Bill Bobrick won his first ABT title by defeating top seed Bobby Rackley by a final score of 184-181 at Bertrands Bowl. Bill was bowling out of the second position in our stepladder finals after posting a 661 series in the semifinals. Bobby Rackley had earned the top spot by one pin with a 662 series. The pressure of the championship match was obvious as both bowlers missed early spare opportunities. By the fourth frame, however, Bobby and Bill settled in for what was to become an exciting race to the wire. After matching spares in the 4th and 5th frames, Bobby strung the next 3 strikes to take a slim 5 pin lead after 8 frames. Bobby then left a 6-7-10 split in the 9th which he couldn't convert which left the door open for Bill who was finishing first. Bill spared in the 9th then struck out in the 10th forcing Bobby to double for any hopes of victory. When Bobby left the 3 pin standing on his first ball in the 10th, the match was over and Bill was our newest champion by a final margin of 3 pins, 184-181.

Bill Bobrick is a 35 year old heavy equipment operator from Wildwood. He is married to Charla and they have a 9 year old daughter named Brandi. Charla and Brandi were both there this week to see Bill win the \$900 first prize. Bill has been bowling for about 20 years and currently bowls leagues at Sunset Bowl and Libertyville Lanes. His high game is 279 which he rolled in this week's semifinals. He also has a 686 series to his credit. Bill was using a Columbia U-2 which was drilled by George Lawrence at Bertrands. Bill taught himself to throw the hook he now uses and said that practice, leagues, and tournament play have helped him to improve his game. Bill thanked Chuck Lindal for convincing him to join the ABT, and his family and all the ABT members for all their support not only during the finals, but in qualifying rounds and semifinals as well. He also thanked the ABT and Bertrands Lanes for having the tournament. Bill and Charla just purchased a piece of land in Salem, Wisconsin and Bill plans on building a house there, so the money he won will go into the bank and be used towards that. Bill said that the ABT is a great tournament for the average bowler. Bill knows that he is going to "graduate" this week and although he hates to go, he knew it was coming. He just wanted to say thanks to all the friends he has made in the ABT who have been rooting for him every week.
