Sally thanked all the spectators for their support especially Gary Vaughn who gave her some advice right before the finals to help her relax a little bit. She also thanked Espo's for the great job they did in hosting our event. Sally said she really enjoys coming in to bowl the ABT because everyone is always so pleasant. She said that the ABT is great experience and that she, Bob, and Pat, are all glad they joined. Sally plans to use her winnings to pay off some bills and for more bowling!
