SUMRALL WINS AT BOLINGBROOK!!!

Tommy Sumrall won his first ABT championship by defeating Jeff McCormick 218-195 at Fair Lanes Bolingbrook. Tommy was top seeded for the stepladder finals after rolling a nice 655 handicap series in the semifinals. Jeff started from the number three spot and had to win two matches to advance to the title game.

Both bowlers struck to open the championship match but Tommy was open in the 2nd when he failed to convert the 1-2 spare. When Jeff made his spare in the 2nd frame Tommy's handicap advantage was gone and it became a scratch match for the rest of the game. Tommy spared in frames 3, 4, and 5 while Jeff went spare, open strike. In frame 6 Jeff chopped the difficult 2-4-5-7 but Tommy couldn't take advantage as he left the 4-10 split to cling to the lead by only 8 pins. Jeff then doubled in frames 7 and 8 to cut the lead to just 1 pin. The 9th and 10th frames, however, belonged to Tommy as he finished with a four-bagger to pull away to the final margin of victory, 218-195.

CHAMPIONS PROFILE: Tommy Sumrall is a 49 year old heavy equipment operator for Ryan Inc. He and his wife, Janine, have three children, Tommy Jr., Gina, and Rose. Tommy has only been bowling for a year and a half and currently bowls at Fair Lanes Bolingbrook. Tommy has a high game of 256 with a 680 series to his credit. He was using an Ebonite Nitro which he had drilled by Steve Jaros at Bolingbrook. Tommy said that he had improved his game by watching others and practicing 10-20 games a day whenever he could. He thanked the ABT, Fair Lanes, and all the spectators who stayed to watch the finals and make them so exciting. Tommy said his winnings would go to his wife since he already has all he needs by having her and their children. Tommy also said that the ABT is a great tournament which is professionally run. He liked the lane conditions this week as he felt there was a good shot that was fair to all bowlers.
