ASHFORD WINS TITLE AT FAIR LANES OAKTON!

Malcolm Ashford won his first ABT title by defeating Laura Kobilnyk 210-188 at Fair Lanes Oakton. Malcolm was seeded second for the stepladder finals after posting a 637 handicap series in the semi-finals. In his first match Malcolm had to come from behind to defeat Greg Roalfs 189-167 to advance to the championship match against top seed Laura Kobilnyk. Laura had been hot all weekend as she was top qualifier with an 870 handicap series and then posted a great 692 to lead all semi-finalists. Laura had a 26 pin handicap advantage for the final match but Malcolm erased that early by opening with a four bagger. Laura stayed close with marks in her first four frames but left a tough 5-10 split in the fifth which she couldn't convert. That was all Malcolm needed as he seized the lead then hung on to claim victory by a final

count of 210-188.

CHAMPION'S PROFILE: Malcolm Ashford is a 41 year old set up man for Fullerton Metals. He is single and has been bowling for about 15 years. Malcolm bowls league at Evergreen Bowl and has a 279 game with a 680 series to his credit. He was using a Black U-Dot this week which he had drilled at Star Pro Shop. Malcolm thanked the Lord for the ability to win and his brother, Karl, who got him started in bowling. He also thanked Greg Roalfs for getting him to join the ABT and the ABT for putting on a great tournament. Malcolm's winnings will be used for a trip to Hiller PA. to see his Mom. Malcolm said that he really enjoys the ABT format. The one on one finals are nervewracking but a lot of fun!
