FAGAN FINISHES FIRST AT DEER PARK!!!

Michael Fagan won his first ABT title by defeating Cheryl Newman 219-200 at Brunswick Deer Park Lanes. Michael was top seeded for our stepladder finals after firing an outstanding 735 handicap series in the semi-finals. Cheryl Newman advanced to the final match by defeating Matt Estep 237-192 and John Bertacchi 180-176. Both bowlers began the title match with spares in the first frame but Cheryl failed to convert the tough 4-6-7 split in the second and Michael doubled in the second and third frames to take a 22 pin lead. Cheryl came right back with a double in the fourth and fifth to close the gap to 13 pins but Michael answered that with another double in frames six and seven to go back in front by 23. Michael and Cheryl matched spares and strikes in frames eight and nine and when Michael made the 1-3-6 spare in the tenth the match was over and he was our newest champion by a final count of 219-200.

Champions Profile: Michael Fagan is a 33 year old Computer Systems Analyst. He is married to Patricia and they have two sons, Mike and Matt. Michael has been bowling for about 25 years and does his league bowling at Deer Park and 3-D Lanes. Michael has a high game of 278 with a high series of 714, both of which were rolled in this week's semi-finals. Michael was using a BUD II and a wine U-Dot which he had drilled by Jerry Cullum at 3-D Lanes in Island Lake. Michael said that he and fellow ABT member Phil Dusza help each other out with their game. Michael thanked his friend Ed Ciesla who was on hand to lend moral support this weekend. He also thanked his wife for putting up with his bowling every week. Michael plans on saving his \$900 winnings to finance a return trip to our Nationals in Las Vegas next March. Michael said that Brunswick Deer Park is a great place to bowl and manager Rick Barbera is a really nice guy. He also said that lane conditions were great and that the ABT is the most enjoyable thing in bowling that he has ever been involved in.

During the 5 minute practice session before squads, bowlers are not allowed to re-rack pins. You are allowed one practice ball at a time on each lane at whatever pins are standing. - Ed.
