TARDIO TAKES TITLE AT LISLE LANES!!!

Ron Tardio became the ABT's newest champion at Lisle Lanes this week but the road to the title was a rocky one. Ron started out by tying Bill Demo for the 3rd and 4th positions in the stepladder finals requiring a one game roll off which Ron won. Bill then opened the stepladder finals by defeating Jack Keith to set up a rematch with Ron. Bill seemed to have the match well in hand as he built up a 34 pin lead after six frames, but Ron came storming back in the last four frames to eke out a 1 pin victory 193-192. Ron's next opponent was Dave Dalke who was looking for his second ABT title. Again Ron was behind after six and again he came on at the end to win another exciting match and move into the championship game against top seeded Mel Apilado. This match followed the same pattern and once again Ron found himself trailing after seven frames, but only by four pins. Mel's spare shooting seemed to desert him in the last few frames as he missed a 10 pin in frame 8, then a 4-7 in frame 10 to really open the door for Ron. Ron took advantage of Mel's misfortunes by converting spares in the last 3 frames to win the match by a final count of 194-179.

Champion's Profile: Ron Tardio is a 47 year old Detailer for Quality Ornamental. He and his wife, Marcie, have three children, Dave, Ron, and Suzanne. Ron has been bowling for about 30 years and currently bowls at Wheaton Bowl. He has a high game of 278 and a 707 series to his credit. Ron was using an AMF Sumo which he had drilled by Paul Marcinek at Lakeside Bowl. Ron credits his dad Sam, and his brother Frank, for helping him to improve his game. Ron thanked Lisle Lanes, the ABT, his wife, his daughter, and everyone who was on hand to lend moral support this week. While Ron said that he had no immediate plans for his winnings, there was a voice in the background that mentioned something about a new golf cart for Marcie! Ron said that the things he loves most about the ABT are the people in it and the professional manner in which it is run.
