Ron has been bowling for about 30 years and currently bowls at Wheaton Bowl. He has a high game of 278 and a 707 series to his credit. Ron thanked Lisle Lanes, the ABT, his wife, his daughter, and everyone who was on hand to lend moral support this week. While Ron said that he had no immediate plans for his winnings, there was a voice in the background that mentioned something about a new golf cart for Marcie! Ron said that the things he loves most about the ABT are the people in it and the professional manner in which it is run.
