Sandy Freda won her first Chicagoland ABT title this past weekend by defeating Bob Thiem 222-208. It was the third ABT title overall for Sandy who is a joint member of the Chicagoland and Milwaukee Divisions of the ABT. Sandy has a singles and a doubles title to her credit in Milwaukee. She advanced to the championship match in our top sixteen match play finals with victories over Lorenzo Jones 205-169, Cleveland Bassett 175-163, and Tracy Ford 217-169. Her opponent in the title match, Bob Thiem, advanced with wins over Sally Kubatzke 226-153, John Harper 232-213, and Kathleen Domagalski 220-186. Bob grabbed the early lead in the match as he struck in three of the first four frames. Sandy kept the match close by converting five straight spares and trailed by only twelve pins after five frames. She then fired strikes in the next three frames to gain the lead by eleven pins after eight frames. Sandy finished first with spares in the ninth and tenth frames leaving Bob in the unenviable position of needing three strikes in the tenth to pull out the win. When Bob's first ball in the tenth came up a little light leaving the 5-8 the match was over and Sandy was our newest champion.

Sandy Freda has been bowling for about 19 years and currently bowls in the ABT travel league in Milwaukee. She has a 267 high game with a 637 high series to her credit. Sandy was using a Cobalt Rhino which she had drilled by Gil Gunther at Nevada Bob's in Milwaukee. She said that her dad, Al Campos, and Don Neu have helped her with her game by giving her tips and a lot of moral support. She thanked Hawthorn Lanes and all the spectators who stayed and cheered her on to victory. Sandy had no immediate plans for the \$1200.00 she won other than a real nice dinner. Sandy said that she is real glad that the ABT allows joint memberships so that members can bowl in different divisions. She was impressed with how clean and well kept Hawthorn Lanes is as well as how consistent the shot was across the entire house. She was even more impressed by the way the Chicagoland members make bowlers from other divisions feel welcome when they come here to bowl.
