He was top seeded in our stepladder finals after posting a 642 handicap series in the semis. His opponent for the title was a red hot Bob Riebe who had just defeated Otto Dreyer 224-188. Dennis was ready, however, as he spared the first two frames then strung a four-bagger from frames 3-6 and was never headed as he went on to win the match by a final score of 236-171.

CHAMPIONS PROFILE: Dennis Moeser is retired and has been bowling for about 30 years. He currently bowls at Red Carpet Regency and Echo Bowl. Dennis has a 289 single with a 719 series to his credit.
