In the third frame I.G. failed to convert the bucket and Michael increased his lead to 13 with a strike. The lead was back down to 2 in the fourth frame as Michael missed a 10 pin and I.G. struck. The bowlers then exchanged marks and after 8 frames it was dead even. I.G. finished first and opened in the ninth then threw strike spare in the tenth forcing Michael to mark in the tenth. Michael's first ball was wide leaving the 1-2-4 which he had to make in order to win. Unfortunately for Michael he pulled his second shot left of the head pin chopping off the 2-4 and I.G. was a winner by a final count of 175-173.
