Morse Wins Title at Lakehurst!

Mary Morse won her first ABT title by defeating Chuck Lindal 225-179 at Brunswick Lakehurst Bowl. Mary rolled a nice 690 handicap series in the semi-finals to claim the top spot in our stepladder finals then sat back and waited while the other four finalists battled for the right to meet her in the championship match. And battle they did as the first three matches weren't decided until the ninth and tenth frames. Each time it was Chuck Lindal, who had qualified fourth, who came through in the clutch to eke out narrow victories and advance to the title match. Chuck started the championship match with a strike but ran into trouble in the second and fourth frames and by frame number five Mary had built a commanding 31 pin lead. Try as he did, Chuck couldn't cut into the lead as Mary stayed clean for the entire game and won the match by a final count of 225-179.

Champions Profile: Mary Morse is a 28 year old Graphic Artist. She and her husband, Kevin, have a two year old son, Tony. Mary has been bowling for about 15 years and currently bowls league at Brunswick Lakehurst. She has a high game of 216 with a 625 series as her personal bests. Mary was using a Columbia Lite Dot which she had drilled at Kennedy's Pro Shop. Mary credits her father in law, Jim Morse, with helping her to improve her game. She thanked the ABT, Lakehurst Bowl and the spectators, especially Craig Hook for a "good luck charm" and moral support during the finals. Mary said that part of her winnings would be used to celebrate her fifth wedding anniversary next week. Mary likes bowling in the ABT because it's not like other competitions that she's been in. There's no stress because all of the other bowlers are so friendly. Mary didn't think she would ever get this far and was really surprised to make the cut for the semis with a -32 score.
